



3) **Maths Shed** - Use your Spelling Shed log in details and practise your number bonds and times tables.



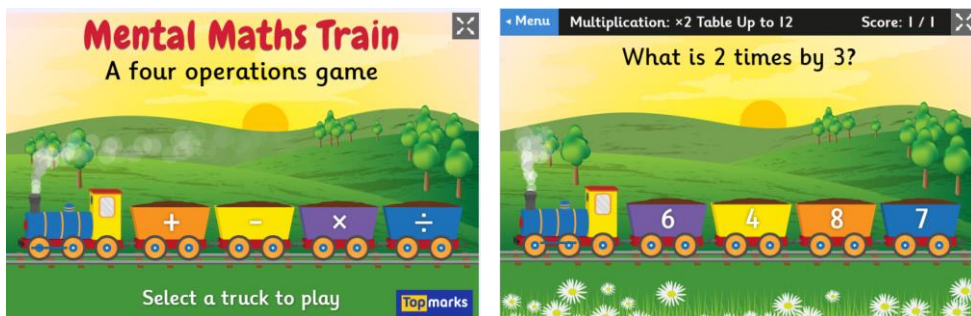

- Roll a dice each. The first person to add or multiply the numbers gets a point/10 points.



5) **Mental Maths Train** - Another online game to help you to quickly recall number bond and times table facts.

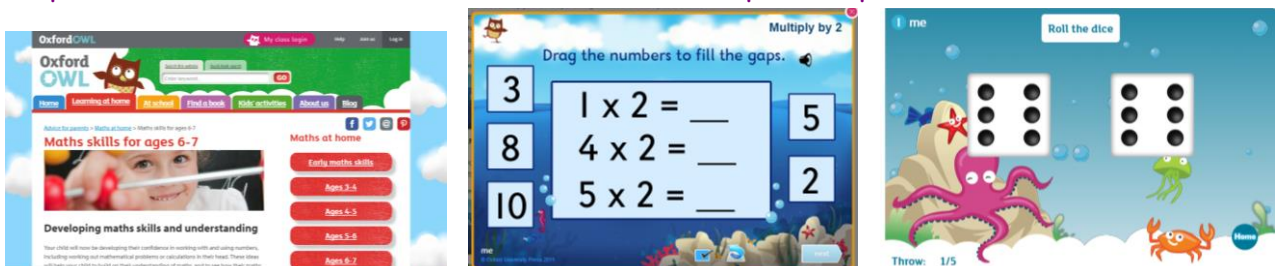
