What is a Junior Leadership Team?

A Junior Leadership Team is a group of children who are elected by class teachers to represent the views of all pupils and to work together to improve our school.

Who are the Junior Leadership Team?

At Malvern Parish, we have two pupils from each class in KS2 who form our Junior Leadership Team.

What will the Junior Leadership Team do?

- The Junior Leadership Team will meet Miss Hughes at least once a month and discuss issues that are important to the children.
- They will have an agenda which will initially be led by the Pupil Questionnaire.
- A member of the JLT will take the minutes and another will chair the meeting.
- The JLT will meet with the governing body to share their work with them.
- They will have a higher level of input into the monitoring of the impact of the changes and improvements across the school
- They will contribute to the school self evaluation document (SEF) and produce a children school self-evaluation
