Online Safety Policy



Online safety is about protecting yourself and your information when you use the internet and other devices that can access the internet like computers, iPads, tablets, games consoles and smart phones.

How can I stay safe online at home?

- Ask adults at home for permission before using the internet and let them know what you'll be doing
- Tell an adult at home if you see something that upsets you or that you don't understand
- Make sure your adults know who you're communicating with online
- Keep your personal information private including pictures of yourself

How can I stay safe online at school?

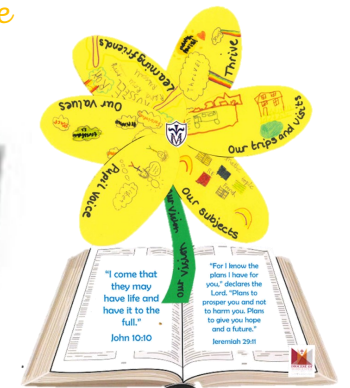
- Only open webpages and programmes that your teacher has told you are appropriate
- Tell your teacher if you see anything that upsets you or that you don't understand
- Ask for permission before using devices in school
- Always keep your passwords and personal details private

What will school do to help you stay safe?

At school, we will teach you lots of ways to stay safe online:

- How to report things you don't like
- How to keep information private
- How to be respectful and polite
- How to spot if someone isn't who they say they are
- Who to talk to if you're having a problem you can't solve

If you're having a problem or have worries about your online safety, tell a grown up at school or home and they can help.
